




EASA f-ATPL: European standard Airline Transport Pilot License. An EASA f-ATPL is recognized in countries that follow EASA (European Union Aviation Safety Agency) regulations, primarily within the European Union and European Economic Area (EEA). With this license, you can operate commercial flights for airlines within EASA member states and in countries that have agreements with EASA.

ICAO f-ATPL: International Airline Transport Pilot License. The ICAO f-ATPL is a globally recognized license, based on International Civil Aviation Organization standards. It allows pilots to operate commercial flights for airlines in countries that follow ICAO regulations provided they meet the local aviation authority's conversion or validation requirements.

GACA CPL: Commercial Pilot License issued by KSA's General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA), allowing commercial operations within the country.

PPL: Private Pilot License is a basic pilot certification allowing individuals to fly for personal or recreational purposes, but not for compensation.
